Course Description

In times of crisis and adversity leadership is essential. The ICISF accredited course **Resilient Leadership** is a unique science based program which prepares leaders to create an organisational culture of resilience. Frontline leaders/managers will find Resilient Leadership especially useful. Topics include resilience oriented communications, the four characteristics that separate effective crisis leaders from others, and common mistakes leaders make.

Learning Objectives
